The project encompassed a comprehensive range of civil infrastructure works, including new pedestrian crossings, footpaths, kerb and gutter works, landscaping, street furniture, signage, and sustainable pavement solutions. Our approach prioritised community safety, environmental sustainability, and long-term durability, ensuring the infrastructure serves the Greenacre community for decades to come.

### Traffic & Safety Management

Licensed traffic controllers on-site at all times with protective barriers, signage, and coordination with TfNSW for temporary bus stop relocation.

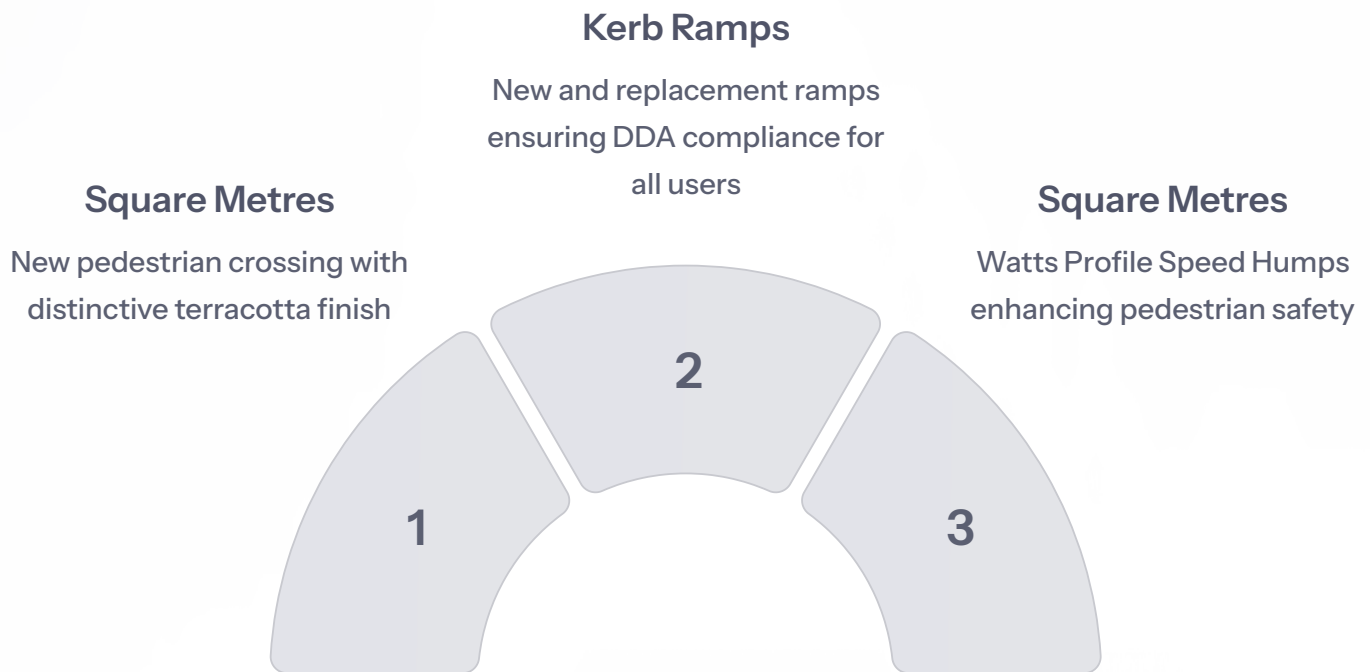
### Concrete & Pavement Works

Construction of distinctive terracotta broom-finish pedestrian crossing, new kerbs, DDA-compliant ramps, and sustainable glass-mix asphalt surfacing.

### Landscaping Enhancement

Native plantings, tree surrounds, structural soil preparation, and community seating to create vibrant, biodiversity-rich streetscapes.

# Community Impact & Environmental Legacy



The Maiden Street project has delivered measurable improvements to community safety, accessibility, and environmental sustainability. The new infrastructure provides wider, safer walking routes whilst incorporating traffic calming measures that protect pedestrians and encourage active transport. Our commitment to environmental responsibility ensured that 28 tonnes of recyclable material were diverted from landfill, whilst native landscaping promotes local biodiversity and reduces long-term maintenance requirements.

## Site Establishment & Survey

Comprehensive dilapidation reporting, utility protection, and community notifications ensuring seamless project commencement.

## Safe Demolition & Excavation

Removal of existing infrastructure with 343 tonnes of waste disposal and 28 tonnes of recyclable material recovery.

## Construction & Installation

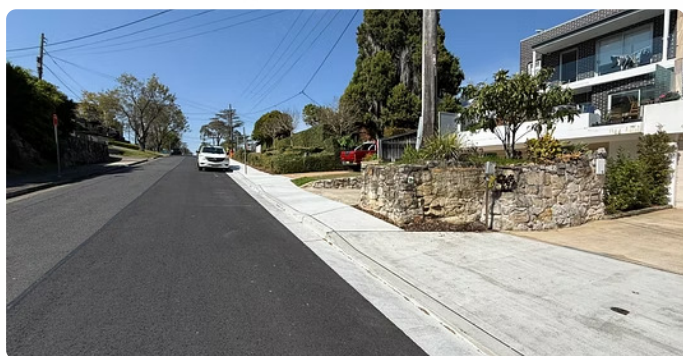
Delivery of new footpaths, crossings, kerbs, and accessibility features with sustainable materials and expert craftsmanship.

## Landscaping & Finishing

Installation of native plantings, turf establishment, and street furniture with 6 weeks of maintenance to ensure successful establishment.
