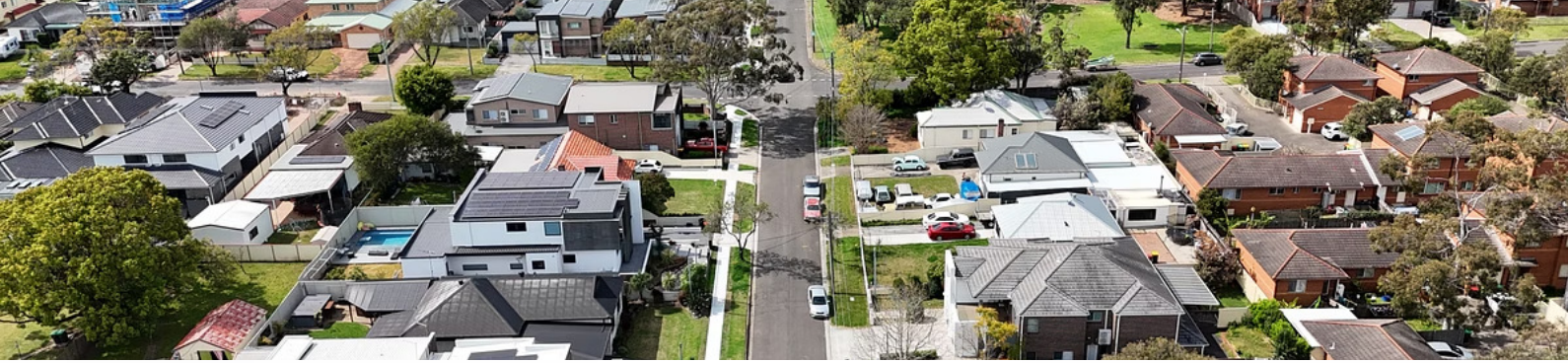
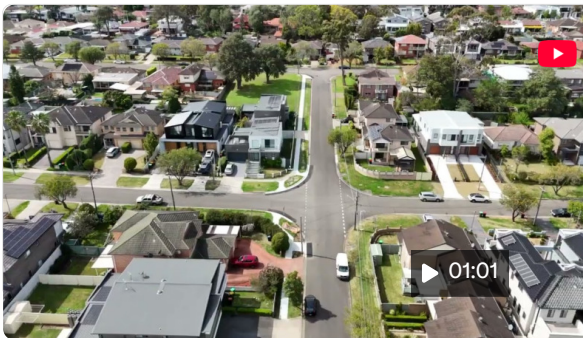




Phillip Street, Panania – Pedestrian Crossing & Footpath Reconstruction

Project Overview & Deliverables

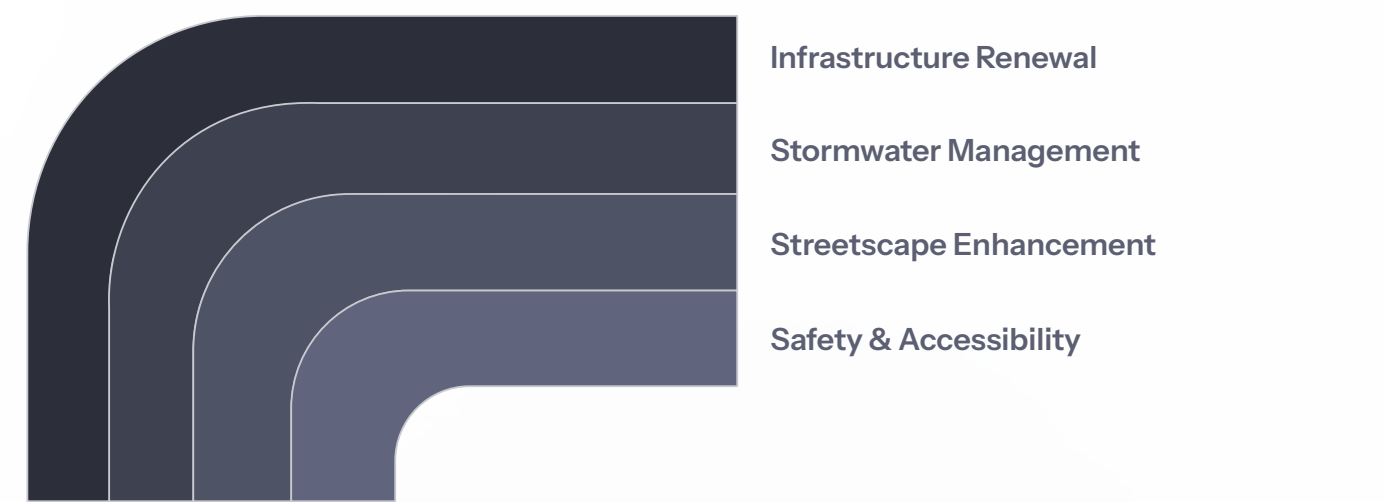
Project Scope

The Phillip Street, Panania project (FY24/25) was designed to renew an ageing pedestrian crossing and deliver new, high-quality footpaths, kerb and gutter works, stormwater upgrades, landscaping, and safer street features.

The works were delivered under strict timeframes, ensuring minimal disruption to residents, commuters, and local businesses, whilst enhancing both functionality and streetscape appeal throughout the entire corridor.

The comprehensive scope included careful removal of 9 outdated kerb ramps, 19 m² of old pavement, and 3.4 m³ of asphalt, making way for modern infrastructure. Additionally, 4 new roof water connections and 16 metres of new drainage pipes were installed, ensuring superior stormwater management for years to come.



Community Impact & Visual Progress



Enhanced Safety

Children walking to school, parents with prams, and older residents now enjoy clearer, wider pathways and safer kerb ramps. Refreshed line markings and speed management features encourage drivers to slow down in this residential area.

Improved Accessibility

10 compliant kerb ramps and 74 m² of new base course deliver improved safety and smoother traffic flow. The upgraded infrastructure ensures full accessibility for wheelchairs, mobility aids, and prams.

Greener Environment

The addition of new turf, garden beds, and carefully maintained trees has brightened the street, creating a more vibrant and welcoming environment for the entire Picnic Point community.

The transformation of Phillip Street represents a significant improvement in quality of life for local residents. With 7 trees carefully trimmed for improved visibility, 27 m³ of landscaping excavation, and 26 metres of new trip stops, the project has created a safer and more inclusive space for all users.

Sustainability & Legacy



Environmental Responsibility

Waste was carefully sorted and transported to Council's Bransgrove Road facility, with recyclable material separated from general waste. Glass-enhanced asphalt reduced reliance on raw materials whilst maintaining superior quality.



Waterway Protection

Sediment and erosion controls ensured protection of local waterways throughout construction. The upgraded stormwater infrastructure with 3 service pits and new drainage systems improves long-term water management.



Safety First

Licensed traffic controllers, protective barriers, and comprehensive signage kept the community and workforce safe. Working along a live local road required careful staging and coordination with all stakeholders.

The Phillip Street, Panania Footpath & Streetscape Upgrade is more than a construction project — it is a community investment. This project reflects High End Civil's dedication to quality, safety, and community well-being, leaving behind a safer, greener, and more connected Picnic Point for generations to come.



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
