Before & After: A Complete Transformation

Before the Upgrade



Before works began, Shellcote Road had become a source of frustration and concern for the entire community. Traffic moved unpredictably through the intersection, creating dangerous conditions for both motorists and pedestrians.

- Traffic moved unpredictably, increasing risks at the intersection
- Old kerbs, pavements, and surfaces were badly worn down
- Poor drainage left standing water after rain, creating hazards
- Pedestrians and local residents found it difficult to move around safely

The roundabout wasn't just an inconvenience – it was a genuine safety issue that affected the daily lives of everyone in the area. Families worried about crossing the road, drivers struggled with unclear traffic patterns, and the deteriorating infrastructure created ongoing maintenance problems.

After the Upgrade



Today, Shellcote Road looks and feels completely different. The transformation has created a space that truly serves the community's needs whilst prioritising safety and accessibility.

- Traffic moves safely and efficiently through the roundabout
- Pedestrians enjoy safer crossings with new kerb ramps and footpaths
- Drainage is reliable, meaning fewer puddles and no waterlogging
- A fresh, well-maintained streetscape has improved the look and character of the area

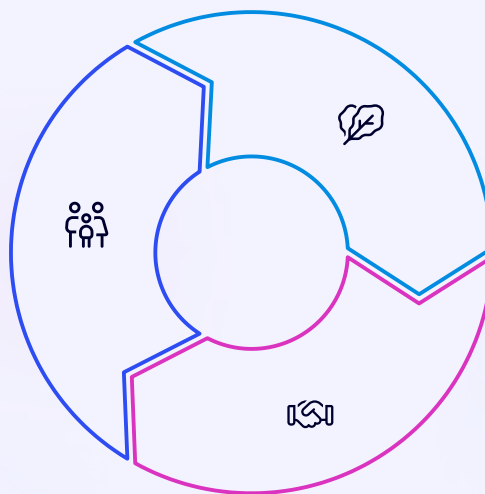

500m² Concrete & Asphalt Old surfaces removed and replaced with stronger, safer materials	165m New Kerb & Gutter Constructed to improve drainage and traffic flow
154m² New Footpaths Laid to make walking safer and easier for residents	94m² Paver Restoration Old pavers uplifted and reinstated, restoring the streetscape

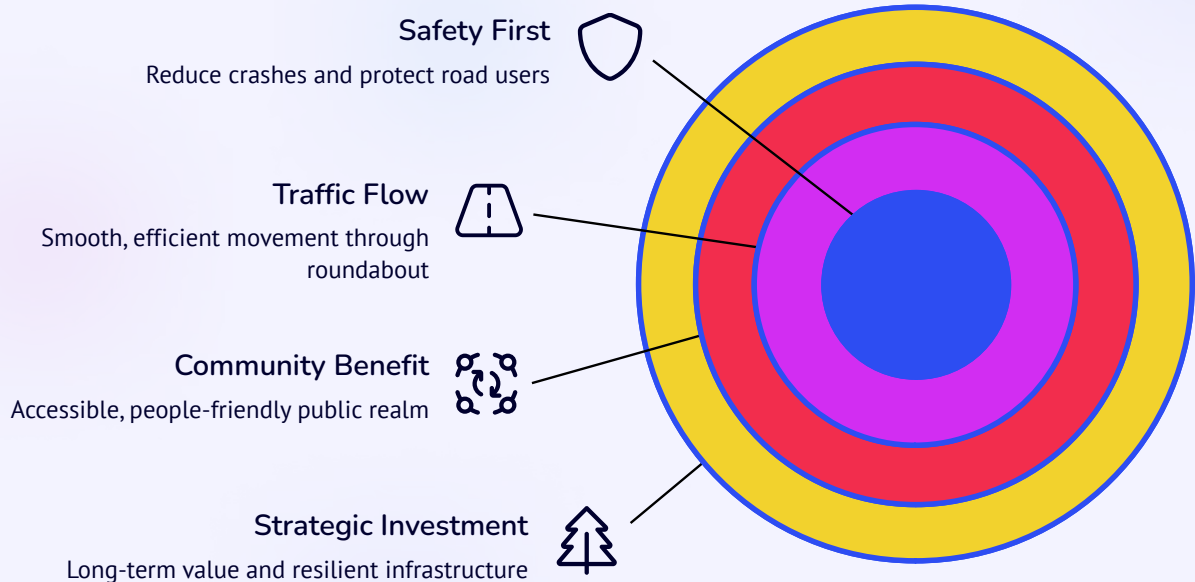


Sustainability & Environment
