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Yangoora Road & Benaroon Road Intersection: Before and After Transformation

Before: A Challenging Bottleneck



Previously, the Yangoora Road and Benaroon Road intersection was a congested T-junction plagued by confusing turn lanes and inadequate signage. This led to severe traffic jams, long delays, and increased emissions. Its complex layout also contributed to frequent minor collisions and near misses, posing significant safety concerns for both drivers and pedestrians. Drivers faced uncertainty, and pedestrians had limited safe crossing options, making it a source of community frustration.

After: A Modern, Efficient Roundabout



The transformation into a modern roundabout has dramatically improved traffic flow and safety. The new design ensures continuous movement, significantly cutting congestion and travel times. By eliminating direct left turns and enforcing yield-at-entry, conflict points are minimized, drastically reducing accidents. The roundabout now features dedicated pedestrian crossings with refuge islands for enhanced safety and landscaped central islands for a more aesthetically pleasing environment, addressing past challenges and supporting future traffic demands.

Project Overview & Deliverables

This busy intersection had long posed challenges — traffic bottlenecks, pedestrian risks, and inefficient access for local vehicles. Canterbury-Bankstown Council identified the urgent need for a comprehensive intersection upgrade, and our team was engaged to deliver a new roundabout that would fundamentally improve safety, manage traffic flow more effectively, and enhance the overall streetscape character.

The works were meticulously planned and staged to ensure the community could continue to move around safely during construction. Our comprehensive approach addressed every aspect of the intersection, from traffic management to pedestrian safety, whilst maintaining accessibility for local businesses and residents throughout the construction period.

Traffic Infrastructure

Over 50m³ of new asphalt pavement laid, delivering a durable, smooth driving surface for years of reliable service.

Safety Features

93 linear metres of new kerb and gutter constructed, improving drainage and guiding traffic safely through the intersection.

Pedestrian Access

More than 120m² of new concrete footpaths built, giving pedestrians safer and easier access around the intersection.



Community Impact & Safety Excellence

This project has had a transformative impact, delivering measurable improvements in safety, efficiency, and neighbourhood character for the Belmore community.



Enhanced Road Safety

The new roundabout significantly improved visibility and reduced conflict points, creating a safer environment for all road users.



Improved Traffic Flow

Smoother traffic movement during peak times reduced congestion and travel delays for residents and through-traffic.



Pedestrian Priority

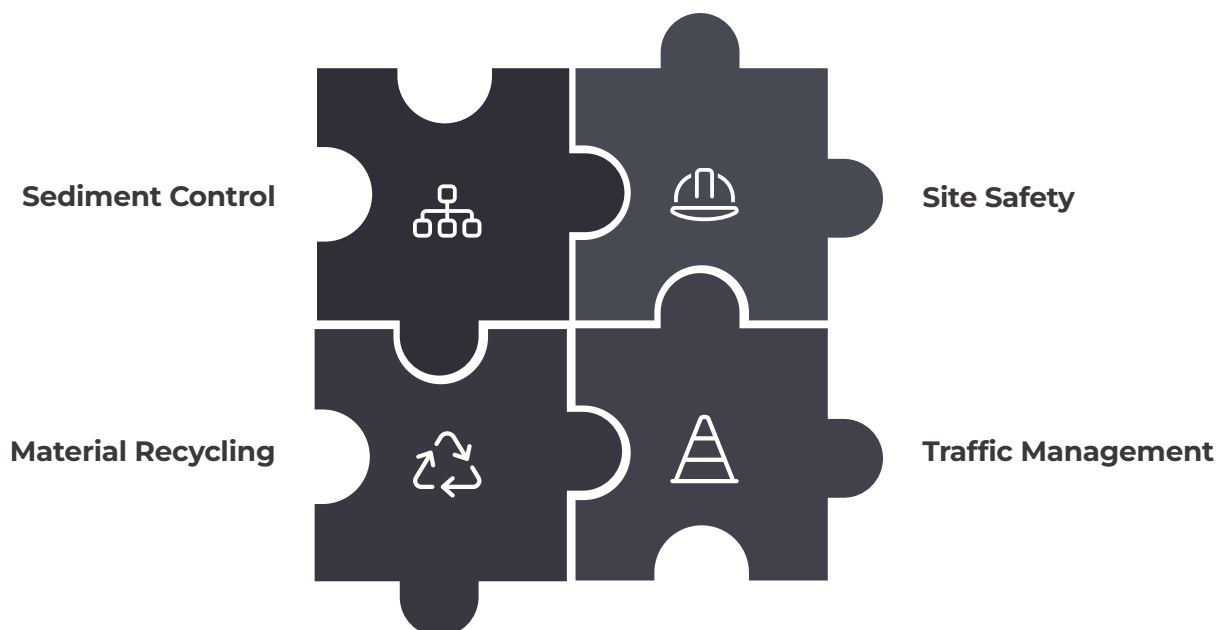
New kerbs, footpaths, and crossing points provide safer pedestrian access, encouraging walking and better connections.
